

Statement Regarding the Restriction of Hazardous Substances

This document is ON Semiconductor's statement regarding the Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 of 31 March 2015 amending Annex II to Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the list of restricted substances (RoHS). The content of this document is based upon information collected from ON Semiconductor supply chain, manufacturing facilities and affiliates worldwide

Products manufactured by ON Semiconductor are in compliance with the amended RoHS directive. Specifically, products manufactured by ON Semiconductor do not contain the substances listed in the table below in concentrations greater than the listed Maximum limit value. This document is periodically updated and is current to include any changes that have occurred since the publication of the original RoHS directive, as indicated by the date below.
